#### **Science**

- BEFORE walking through the Marsh, tell students they will need to identify at least five living and non-living environmental factors.
- Once they reach the end of the bridge, have them share what they . observed.

### Language Arts

- Ask students to pair up in teams of 2 or 4. Each team should pick one bird • to read about in the exhibit.
- After reading, ask student teams to compare and contrast the two birds using the information they read about.

## **Social Studies**

- Instruct students to read the information in the California Condor section of the hall (before the Rainforest).
- Ask students: What are some ways Californians are using the land? In • what ways are those uses impacting the California condor? Are there changes to the way we use the land that might help protect this species?
